
Dear Solar Installers,

Benton PUD feels it is important to provide updates to the State's solar incentive program.

As you are aware, Benton PUD is subject to our specific credit limit cap of \$1.8 million or the statewide cap of \$110 million, whichever occurs first. Benton PUD's credit limit cap is not yet fully allocated, however the statewide cap is fast approaching and could be fully allocated at any time. Once the state-funded incentives are fully allocated, WSU will immediately stop accepting applications to the program

We are moving toward the statewide \$110 million incentive limit (the "Statewide Cap") at a remarkable pace. Over the last month, additional new projects applied toward the cap increased by approximately \$10 million. Some utilities in the state have already reached their individual program caps and have completed projects that may not be eligible for participation under the Incentive Program. Given that other utilities are approving solar projects as fast as or faster than Benton PUD, and we do not know how many projects are pending, the Incentive Program may hit the Statewide Cap sooner than originally anticipated. In light of this possibility, we are recommending you provide the following information to your customers considering the installation of new solar systems:

- In the near future, Benton PUD may be required to suspend or stop
 its participation in the state Incentive Program as the program gets
 closer to its \$110 million incentive limit. If this occurs, Benton PUD
 will attempt to notify all local solar installers. Customers and their
 installers should check www.bentonpud.org, for the most up-to-date
 information regarding current participation in the Incentive
 Program.
- When considering the installation of a new solar system, customers and their contractors should also monitor the current state Incentive Program limits by visiting WSU's "Program Summary" website at: http://www.energy.wsu.edu/RenewableEnergySystemIncentiveProgram.aspx
- 3. Given this funding uncertainty, Benton PUD cannot provide assurances that incentives will be available under the Incentive Program for any individual solar project. All new customer interconnection applications will now require a "Production Incentives Risk Acknowledgement Form" (attached) to be signed by the customer. This form outlines the risk surrounding Washington State Renewable Energy System Incentive Program funding availability. We appreciate your assistance in keeping your customers informed of this development. You should also be aware that as we get closer to the Statewide Cap, Benton PUD may limit its participation in the Incentive Program to avoid the risk of exceeding available funding.
